Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child has recently come along to B3 Youth at Bethel Bedwas. This letter is to give you all the necessary information about club - please read it and talk through the rules with your child.

Where: Bethel Baptist Church, Church St. Bedwas, CF83 8ED

When we meet: 7.30-9.00pm

Who can come: Young people in yrs 7-10

Team leaders: The group leader is Sonya Palmer who oversees a team of helpers.

Limitations:

For everyone's safety and for smooth running of the club we can currently take a maximum of 30 young people. This is to comply with our Safeguarding policy and risk assessment.

What we do:

Club features a mix of activities, games, places to sit and relax. We have boardgames, a PS4 and pool, table football and table tennis.

We care about young people's wellbeing - physical, emotional, spiritual. In this church youth group we will talk about the Christian faith and how knowing God relates to life in this world.

All our team are volunteers and Christians. All have undergone (or are in the process of undergoing) an application process and DBS check.

Rules:

Because we have young children's clubs before Youth it is extremely important that youth don't arrive at church before 7.25pm. **If they do they will be asked to leave without disturbing our neighbours and return at the correct time.**

In our words and actions every member must respect:

- the team
- each other
- our neighbours
- and our property

All attendees must return a consent form on their second visit - if we do not have an up-to-date consent form this will result in non-entry.

Club requires £1 subs - this helps us afford refreshments and maintain our equipment - 2 weeks non-payment may result in non-entry.

Please talk through these rules with your child. Any breach of these rules will result in your child being asked to leave. Should this happen we will aim to contact you to let you know.

What we need from you:

As parents and carers we need to be able to get in touch with you in the case of any emergency. The contact number you provide may be added to a Whatsapp community (a one-way group) where we can let you know any important information eg. Cancellations, special events etc. We need to be made aware of any relevant allergies/medical conditions and know that you consent for the child in your care to:

- attend club
- receive medical attention in an emergency
